Itinerary:

Day 1: Arrival day at Fish Eagle River Camp

Day 2: Explore the river on a guided tour

Day 3: Depart back to CPT

Destination: Fish Eagle River Camp, Breede River

Description:

Fish Eagle River Camp is our private campsite situated on the banks of the Breede River, approximately 30kms from Swellendam. A safari styled camp with lush green grass and plenty of shade set within a tranquil valley. Awake to the sounds of the African Fish Eagle and look out for the resident tortoises.

The camp is set within the Renosterveld Project (as one of the last remaining biomes of indigenous renosterveld). This provides a unique natural transition of wildlife between the farmlands.



Detailed Itinerary:

Day 1: Depart from your school meeting point and head out along the N2 towards Riviersonderend. A short stop for refreshments and bathrooms before making your way to Fish Eagle River Camp to meet the Xama Africa Team for an exciting adventure. On arrival we will settle in, be assigned safari style dome tents and receive an introduction + orientation before lunch is served. The afternoon will enjoy some camp ice breakers and activities. Dinner will be enjoyed around the campfire in the central boma overlooking the river, with marsh mellow and camp stories.

Day 2: After a delicious full breakfast, we will be transported upstream to our put-in point from where we will embark our river journey. After a thorough safety brief and allocation of safety gear we will spend the day paddling down the river, negotiating rapids and channels. Always lots of laughter and fun! The river crew will spy a river beach where they will prepare a river side picnic midway through, before continuing to base camp. Once you have returned you will have the chance to freshen up and settle back in at camp. The evening will allow for some grade-appropriate activities (quiz, talent show, group charades, cooking, myth busters etc) and more stories around the campfire. A mouthwatering dinner is prepared over open fire and enjoyed at the central boma overlooking the Breede River.

Day 3: The last morning always comes to soon as we pack up camp and head home with some great memories and experiences. We hope to see you again soon on one of your next adventures with Xama Africa.
